## **LA PORTE COUNTY METRO OPERATIONS ARRESTS THREE (3) IN LA PORTE HOME**

On Wednesday, July 23, 2014 investigators from the La Porte County Metro Operations Unit and officers from the La Porte Police Department executed a search warrant at a home located at a residence in the 200 block of Darlington Street in La Porte. The resulting investigation led to the arrest of three (3) persons who were in the home.

30 year old Kenyatta ROBINSON of Chicago was detained and subsequently transported to Indiana University Health La Porte Hospital. He remains in the hospital and upon his release he will be charged with Dealing in Cocaine or a Narcotic Drug, a Level 4 felony, Common Nuisance, a class "B" misdemeanor and Resisting Law Enforcement, a class "A" misdemeanor. Once released from the hospital he will be transported to the La Porte County Jail. He will be held without bond because he is currently on probation through La Porte County Circuit Court.

38 year old Daniel HENSELL, who resided in the home, was charged with Common Nuisance, a Level 6 felony. He was transported to the La Porte County Jail and released after posting a \$755 bond.

26 year old Robert L. MILLER of East Chicago was also charged with Common Nuisance, a class "B" misdemeanor. He is currently being housed in the La Porte County Jail in lieu of \$355 bond.

These recent arrests are the result of on-going investigations involving the distribution of narcotics and illegal drugs in and around the La Porte area. Sheriff Michael Mollenhauer stated: "These arrests should send a clear message that La Porte County law enforcement will not tolerate those who hope to set-up shop and distribute narcotics in our community. Those that do will be sought out, charged and jailed." As a result of this investigation, additional arrests are anticipated. The public is encouraged to report potential drug activity to the La Porte County Metro Operations Unit by calling (219) 325-9022. The Metro Operations Unit is a multi-jurisdictional drug task force comprised of investigators from the La Porte County Sheriff's Office and La Porte Police Department.

\*The charges against the defendants are merely accusations, and the defendants are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
