### **WANTED PERSONS LOCATED IN TENNESSEE AND RETURNED TO JUSTICE**

On July 25, 2014 deputies from the La Porte County Sheriff's Office Warrants Division traveled to Tennessee and extradited two (2) wanted persons back to La Porte County. 50 year old Richard MAYNARD and 40 year old Christine STULTZ, also known as Christine RIEGLE, had been wanted as the result of an investigation that had been conducted by the La Porte County Metro Operations Unit. The two had been detained in Coffee County, Tennessee when law enforcement learned that they were wanted in Indiana.

Richard MAYNARD was wanted for outstanding criminal warrants for Dealing Methamphetamine, a class "B" felony, Possession of Anhydrous Ammonia, a class "D" felony and Failure to Appear. Christine STULTZ was wanted for Unlawful Sale of a Precursor, Common Nuisance, Possession of Methamphetamine, Possession of a Schedule IV Controlled Substance, Possession of Hash Oil, all of which are class "D" felonies. The warrants for MAYNARD and STULTZ had been issued by La Porte County Circuit Court.

MAYNARD is being held in the La Porte County Jail with no bond. STULTZ has since posted bond and has been released.

This recent arrest is the result of on-going investigations involving the distribution of narcotics and illegal drugs in La Porte County. The public is encouraged to report potential drug activity to the La Porte County Metro Operations Unit by calling (219) 325-9022. The Metro Operations Unit is a multi-jurisdictional drug task force comprised of investigators from the La Porte County Sheriff's Office and La Porte Police Department.
